Volunteer Policies and Procedures

HOW TO REGISTER

- Fill out your personal information the top of the registration and mail it / drop it off by **June 1**.
- Choose dates and your involvement. Signing up for a series of dates will allow us to schedule the entire season at one time. The season schedule and performances are all listed.
- Please note that some dates change due to the production schedules in the summer.
- Registrations are taken on a first come first served basis, so please indicate second and third choices. The earlier you register the better chance you can get your desired dates and shows since there are limited spaces available!

FOR USHERS

- Dress Code – Attire on duty shall consist of a solid white shirt, blouse, or sweater and black pants/shorts, or skirt. Please remember the warm weather.
- As a courtesy to others please do not wear perfume or cologne. All volunteers are expected to practice good personal hygiene.
- Time of arrival is **one hour prior to curtain time** (6:30pm for a 7:30pm) and typically light cleaning up after performance.
- All ushers will be assigned a position by the House Manager (ticket scanner, greeter, merchandise table, playbills/seating, etc.)

CAST/CREW DINNER

- Technical Rehearsals are long 12-hour days, and after constructing the set on stage and hanging all of the lights, volunteers have set up hot food/dinner/drinks/snacks for our team. This happens the Tuesday evening before each new production right at the Playhouse. You can meet the whole production team and cast involved in the show!
